We have planned for a 56-passenger commercial motor coach to take everyone to Austin in style and comfort. **WE MUST FILL THE BUS WITH 56 PEOPLE IN ORDER FOR THIS TO HAPPEN.** The cost will be **\$150.00** per person, that is for round trip. You will not have to worry about driving in the upcoming holiday weekend traffic that will be going on that weekend, nor will you have to worry about driving through Fort Worth, or Waco traffic. Just sit in comfort and visit with all the other Elks and sip on a drink if you like. If you have already investigated, parking at our host hotel, parking alone, will cost you **\$56.00 per day.** The cost of the bus trip alone will save you money, not counting the wear and tear and fuel on your personal vehicle.**

**The bus will pick up passengers at the Edmond Elks Lodge at 7am on June 29 so anyone that is close to the OKC would be able to leave their car at that lodge and it would be safe. From there the bus will travel south to Pauls Valley, we will make a stop at the Chisholm Corner truck stop at exit 72 off I-35 on the east side to pick-up any passengers from that surrounding area at 8:30am. Then from there the bus will go to the Ardmore Elks Lodge to pick up anyone else that would like to go and will leave Ardmore around 9:45am. We will make rest stops along the way and should reach Austin around 4pm. It will be a FUN trip; **WE MUST HAVE THE BUS FULL TO CAPACITY IN ORDER FOR THIS BUS TRIP TO HAPPEN. SO, IF YOU WANT TO GO, PLEASE TALK IT UP IN YOUR LODGE AND GET YOUR MEMBERS EXCITED AND GET THEM ON BOARD.****
